Karachi - Members board of trustees Alamgir Welfare Trust Int'l express their grief over the tragic incident of stempede occurred at Khori Garden when an individual was distributing flour sacks to needy women. They also prayed to Almighty for a prosperous economy to eradicate such incidents in future.

The statement was issued here at Karachi by Mr. Shakeel Dehelvi, Director Public Relations Alamgir Welfare Trust International. He added that according to distinguished economists of the country, the inflation has risen manifolds during the past few years which not only affected the blue collar class but even the white collar class is forced to look towards the welfare organizations like ours to make their ends meet.

To face such a critical situation individuals and government authorities must react rationally to plan a proper strategy. He stressed that the responsibilities lie mainly on welfare Organizations.
